Children who are accommodated under voluntary agreement with their parents (section 20);

Children who are the subject of a care order (section 31) or interim care order (section 38);

Children who are the subject of emergency orders for their protection (section 44 and 46);

Children who are compulsorily accommodated. This includes children remanded to the local authority or subject to a criminal justice supervision order with a residence requirement (section 21).
