Worcestershire County Economic Summary

Comment: The claimant count decreased in May 2021 by 985 to 16,935 and the number of claimants aged 18-24 decreased by 235 to 3,215. Comparisons with March 2020, prior to the impact of the pandemic, show that the claimant count has increased by 8,630 or 104% and the number of claimants aged 18-24 has increased by 1,620 or 102%. Enhancements to Universal Credit as part of the UK government's response to the coronavirus mean that an increasing number of people became eligible for unemployment-related benefit support, although still in work. Consequently, changes in the Claimant Count will not be wholly because of changes in the number of people who are not in work.
