- Creating and maintaining a Unique Learner Number (ULN) and an Individual Learning Record (ILR) for learners.
- Meet ng statutory requirements, such as report ng to the Government on courses.
- Service improvement and planning.
- Prevent on and detect on of crime.
- Financial transact ons.
- Research, including consultations.
- Equality monitoring.

Personal Information Collected and Lawful Basis

The service processes personal information relevant to individual cases, which may include but is not limited to:

- Course details of the course(s) you have signed up to.
- Personal details, including name, address, date of birth, home and mobile phone numbers, and emergency contact informat on.
- Personal reference numbers such as Unique Learner reference nu s, su

ren

The legal bases for processing this personal informat on are:

- Contract for the supply of services.
- Compliance with a legal obligation.
- Tasks carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of of cial authority.
- Consent, for example, for research quest onnaires.

Who We May Share Your Information With

We may need to share the personal informat on you provide or that we collect about you with partner organisat ons where relevant to the individual and/or their use of the learning provision. These include but are not limited to:

- Other Worcestershire County Council services as appropriate, including Legal Services.
- Voluntary agency partners.
- Government departments.
- National regulators and agencies.
- Other local authorit es.
- Third-party contractors.
- Funding bodies.
- Worcestershire District and City Councils.
- The Department for Educat on (DfE), including the Learning Records Service (LRS) and the Educat on and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).
- The English European Social Fund (ESF) Managing Authority or its agents.
- The National Careers Service.

Informat on will only be shared when strictly necessary to provide effective services, and you may have the right to refuse. We will not pass your informat on to any other parties unless required by law or in all reasonable circumstances where disclosure is fair and warranted for processing purposes or subject to a data protect on exempt on.

Specific data-sharing agreements are in place with local agencies, and sometimes the law requires us to share your details with third parties, for example, to prevent crime.

Retention of Your Information

The standard record retent on periods are as follows:

- For courses funded solely by the ESFA, data is retained for 6 years af er the academic year in which your enrolment occurs.
- For courses funded through ESFA match-funding with the European Social Fund, data is retained for three years af er the European Commission's final payment. For the 2014–2020 ESF Programme, this is expected to be until at least 31 December 2030.
- Addit onal legal holds under the Inquiries Act 2005 may override standard retent on periods.
